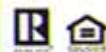

This beautiful eight-year-old house in the Overlook subdivision of Westerville has an ideal walkout lower level. The approximately 2,000-square-foot lower level was designed to incorporate a large theatre room, adjoining bar/entertainment area, workout room, game area and a large bathroom complete with a steam shower. The windows and patio door on the exterior allowed sufficient natural light, but the open floor plan design with other recessed lighting

makes the space as comfortable as the above ground floors. Oak materials, ceramic tile and cultured marble all are duplicated in the lower level. The newly finished lower level accommodates the homeowners' lifestyle and adds significantly to the resale value of the home.
